GIRL POWER SUMMER CAMP 2019

Girl Power Summer Camp was a 10-week all-day program with a girls-only experience designed to meet the needs of girls ages 6-12! We focus on supporting girls' development, growth in math & science, self-reliance, fitness and creative expression through weekly themed activities. YW GIRL/YW READY PROGRAM

The YW GIRL/YW READY PROGRAM is a collaboration funded by the Fund For Women. The goal of the collaboration is to improve the high school graduation rates for girls. Girls Inc. of Delaware is one of the organizations working with the collaboration lead by the YWCA of Delaware. The program was held for 4 weeks from July 16 – August 16, 2019 covered topics such as: academic success and, social and emotional skills building for girls 13 – 16. During the sessions girls presented their career aspirations for "a day in the life of" a chosen career.

CAREER & COLLEGE READINESS YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Girls Inc. of Delaware launched our Career and College Readiness Youth Development Program (CCR YDP). The CCR YDP is an integrated, hands-on approach to college, career exploration while learning for girls 13 -18. Girls receive information and tools to support how to achieve graduation by mentorship and so much more. This Summer's programs were in partnership with industry professionals from Bank of America, community in-kind space support from the Wilmington Library and Simpson United Methodist Church. Topics included career opportunities in finance, digital media, communication, engaging with peers, conflict resolution and social media do's and don'ts.

Learning While Leading or Leading While Learning

Often I'm asked to explain exactly what I do at GIDE. Depending on the audience my responses include: data, extreme details or they can be general to make the receiver aware of the organization. During one of my recent speaking engagements I had an aha moment-I am learning while leading or leading while learning. I titled the talk- Learning While Leading or Leading While Learning.

As a child it was more than difficult to get me to eat fruits or vegetables. My Mom developed a very unique way to encourage me to eat more nutritiously. She would give me a banana, when I ate the entire banana, I would be able to put the sticker on my forehead. I continued this practice into adulthood (yes, really) until a few years ago because people would often say "You know you have something on your forehead?" Now I place the sticker on my left hand. I shared the story with girls during our Summer Camp and amazingly some started to eat more fruit. If a sticker was available, they placed the sticker on their cheek, forehead, or hand. When they told me why it was a reminder regardless of my position, girls are always listening, learning and watching-I must be the best example in order to support their growth and development. Not to mention, I'm leading as I encourage healthy and nutritious eating (this is funny because today I remain a very, very, very picky eater).

Their ability to pick up on the smallest matters and innocence is one of the greatest joys of my position while being the encouragement needed during the most challenging day. **THEY SAY MUCH WITHOUT SPEAKING**. They remind me I must take each opportunity to push ahead and make a difference. When people ask me "What's a day like for me?" I'll share my learning while leading or leading while learning encounter and will likely have a banana sticker on my left hand, too.

WELCOME TO GIRLS INC. OF DELAWARE IN KENT COUNTY!


